

Why focus on Open Contracting?




9.5 trillion dollars approxiately, move between contracts that the world's governments have with the private sector

What is Open Contracting?



Open Contracting is a growing movement focused on enhanced disclosure and participation in public contracting, at all stages of the contracting process, and all types of contracts



Disclosure + Participation

Open Contracting can help with:

- Fiduciary risk management
- Identify/Mitigate Corruption
- Keeping within budget
- On-time delivery
- Compliance with specifications
- Beneficiaries' satisfaction
- Increase Trust






