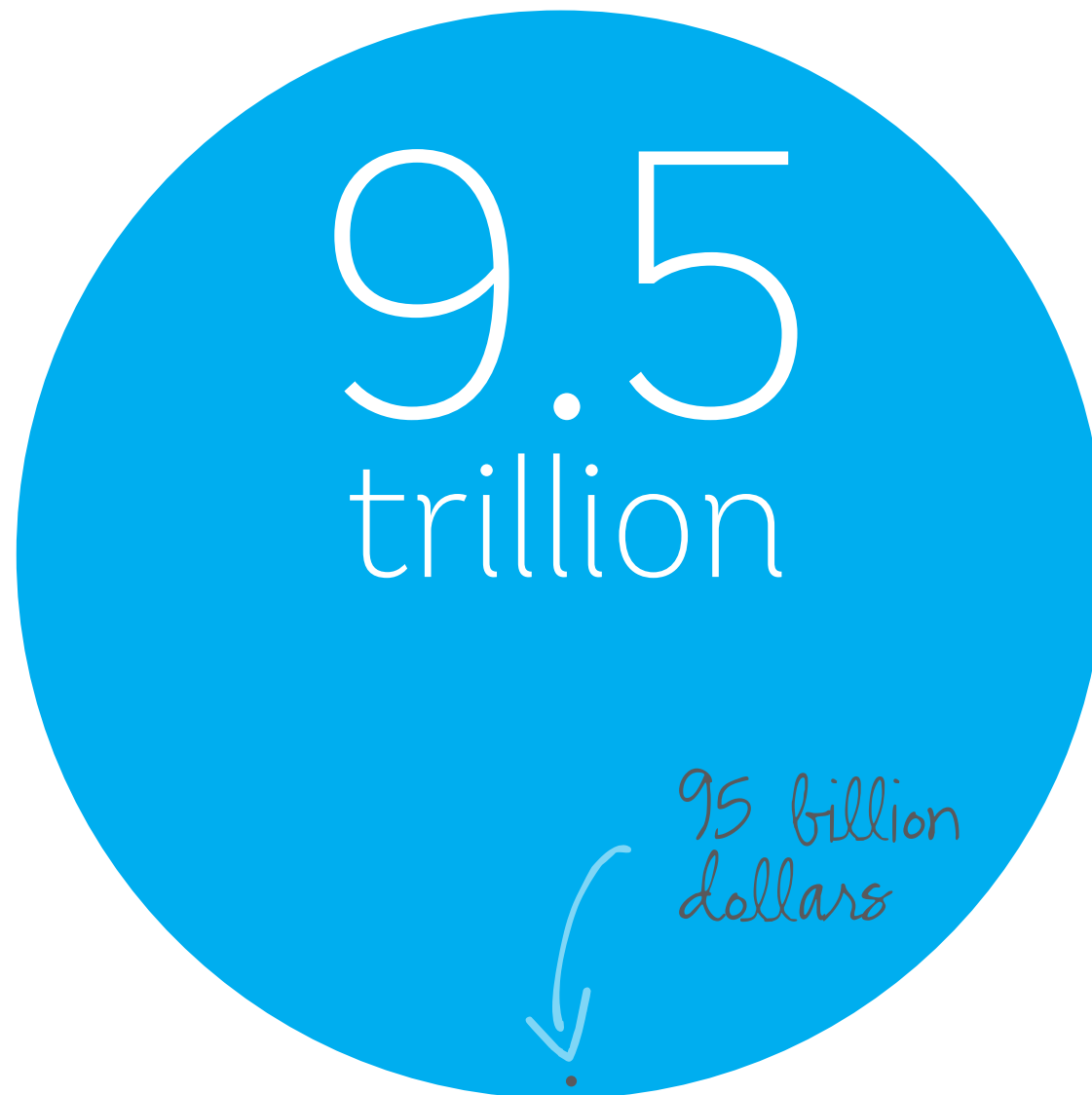

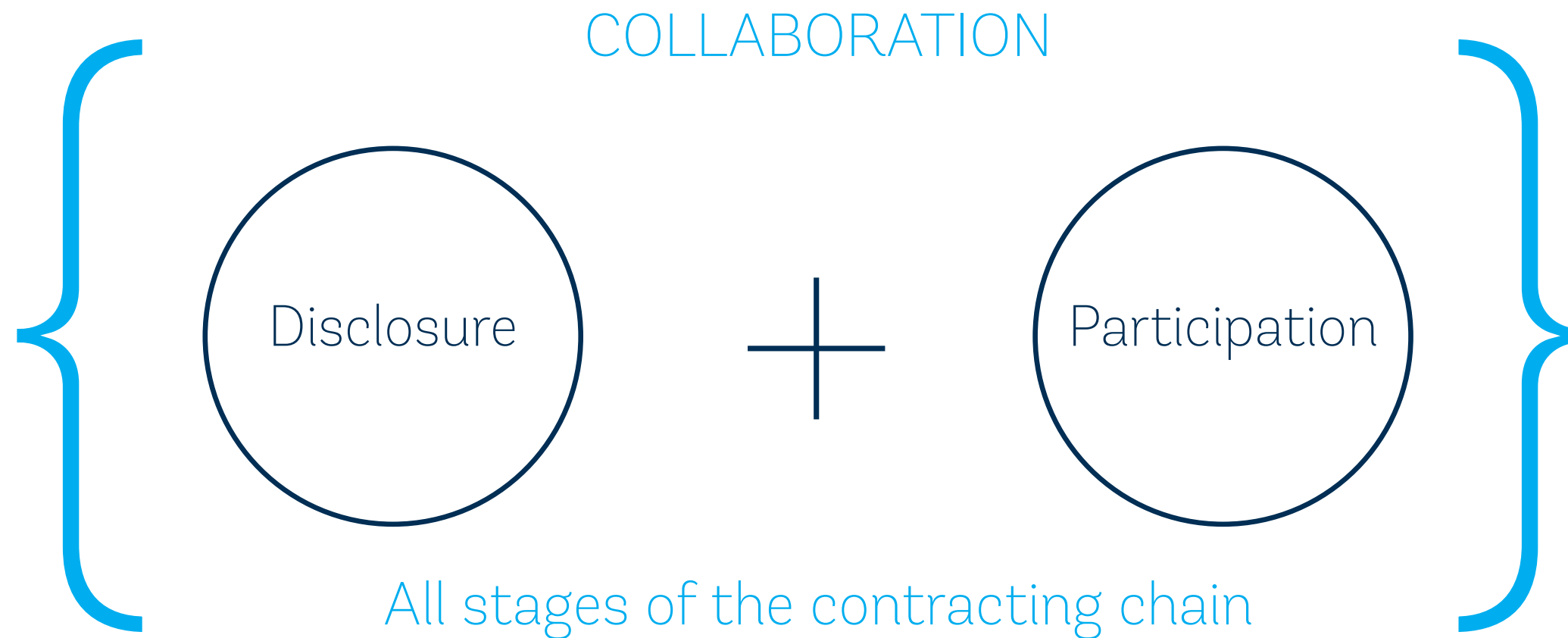
Why focus on Open Contracting?

What is Open Contracting?



Open Contracting is a growing movement focused on enhanced disclosure and participation in public contracting, at all stages of the contracting process, and all types of contracts

Disclosure + Participation

Open Contracting can help with:

- ▶ Fiduciary risk management
- ▶ Identify/Mitigate Corruption
- ▶ Keeping within budget
- ▶ On-time delivery
- ▶ Compliance with specifications
- ▶ Beneficiaries' satisfaction
- ▶ Increase Trust

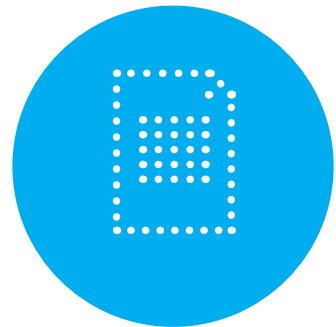

Tender



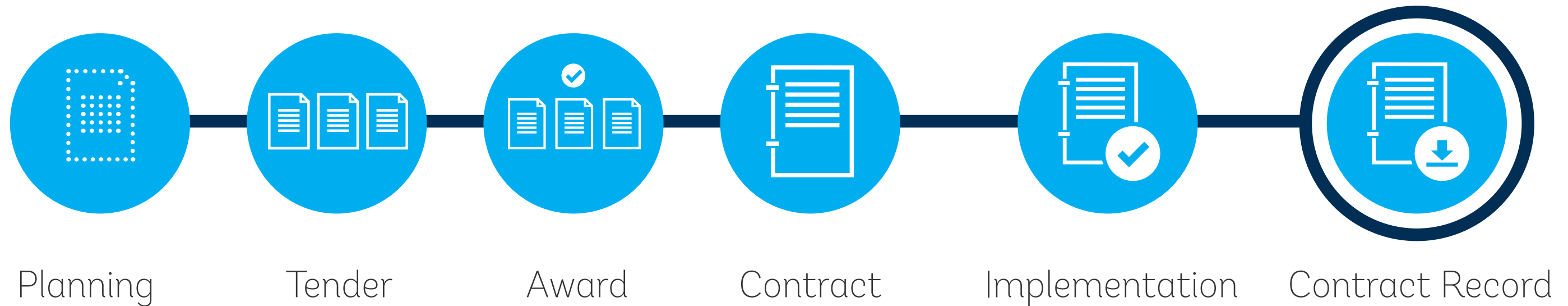
Award


