





Administrative Procedure Code General Provisions

Subject Matter and Scope

- **Proposals** may be made for improvement of the organization and operation of the administrative authorities or for addressing other matters falling within their competence
- Alerts may be submitted about abuse of power and corruption, mismanagement of State or municipal property and about other legally non-conforming or inexpedient actions or omissions of administrative authorities and officials in the relevant administrations, which affect State or public interests, rights or legitimate interests of other persons.

Administrative Procedure Code General Provisions

Principles

- The authorities shall be obligated to consider and address the proposals and alerts within the established time limits objectively and in conformity with the law.
- No one may be persecuted solely by reason of submission of a proposal or alert under the terms and according to the procedures established by AP Code
- >Any individual, organization and the ombudsman, may submit a proposal or alert

Administrative Procedure Code General Provisions

Handling Proposals and Alerts

- Administrative Authorities shall determine the rules and arrangements and are responsible for the overall handling of proposals and alerts
- >Proposals and alerts may be written or verbal, may be submitted by any means of communication (in person, by telephone, telegraph, fax, mail, e-mail etc.) and shell be registered
- >On anonymous proposals or alerts no proceeding shall be instituted

General Provisions MoI Code Directorate Inspectorate, Department "Anti-corruption in MoI"

Art. 150a

(1) Directorate Inspectorate is realizing the supervisory powers of the Minister of Interior exerting direct administrative control over the activities of the MoI personnel

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- (5) In fulfillment of its functional obligations stated in Para (1) DI:
- 4. Exerts administrative control and methodologically assists the MoI structures in their activities for identification and curbing corruption, conflicts of interests and breaches of the MoI Code of Ethics;
- 5. Performs inspections and responds to the received alerts, proposals and complaints;
- 6. Prepares standpoints and expertise concerning legal and other internal acts;
- 7. Performs other obligations pertained to legal acts or assigned by the Minister of Interior.
